Hurricane Florence– Temporary Funding Suspension (REVISED)

Effective Immediately

FEMA Emergency Declaration [EM-3401](#) and [EM-3400](#) were declared September 10th, 2018 with additional counties added on September 13th and 17th, 2018. In preparation for the landfall of Hurricane Florence, MSF has suspended closing & funding in select counties North Carolina and South Carolina as indicated below. **The closing & funding suspension has been lifted as of September 19th, 2018.**
